- Honoring student voice

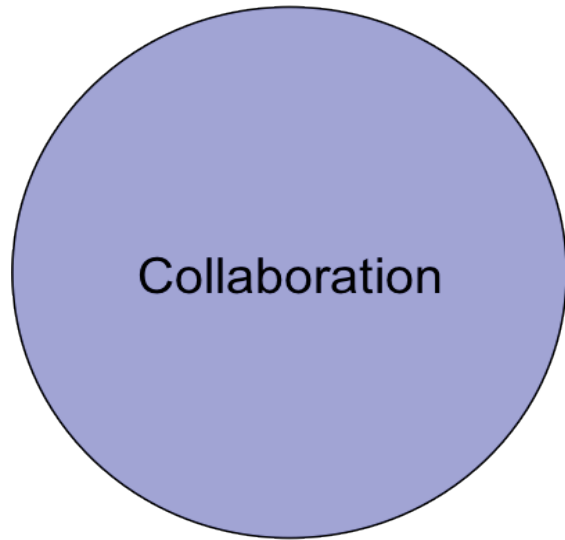

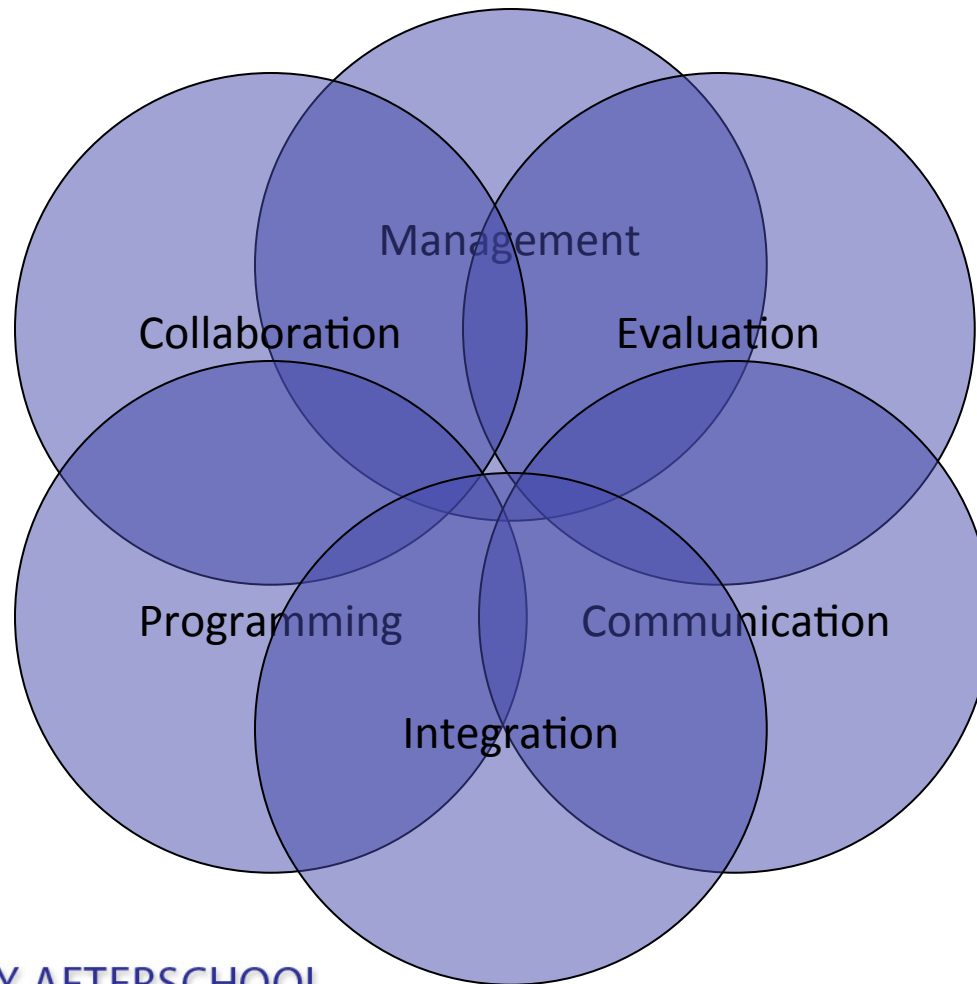
