


Camouflage: To hide by disguise



Panels - squares or rectangles that contain a single scene


•Gutters- space between panels


•Speech Bubbles- contain communication between/ among characters

•Thought Bubbles- contain a character's thoughts


•Captions- contain information about a scene or character

•Sound Effects visual sound clues i.e.. Wonk! Pow!


