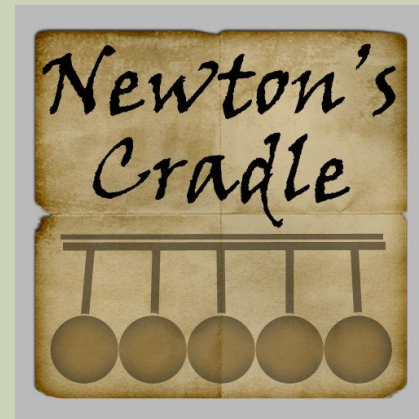
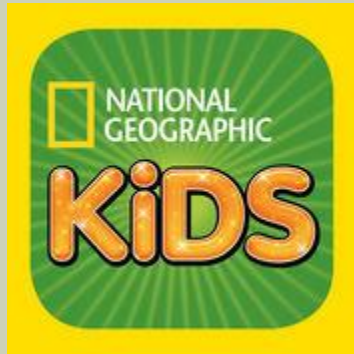
Geyser Riser >

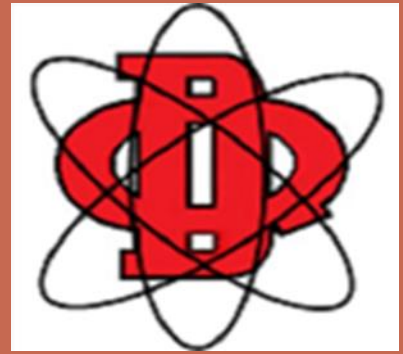

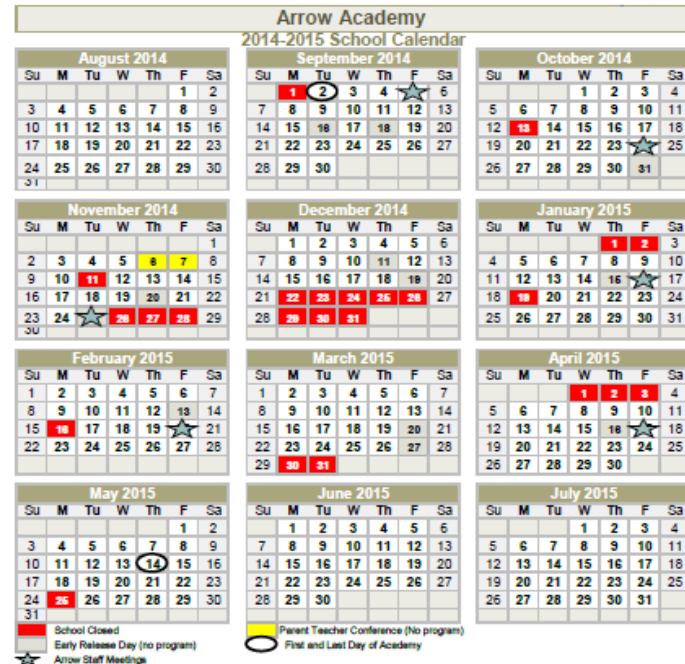
