Definition of Terms

Advisory Boards: A diverse group of stakeholders who meet on a consistent basis, who are committed to the improvement and sustainability of community school programs

CQIP: A self-evaluation tool that assists community schools with holistic improvement efforts.

YPQA: A specific tool to evaluate internally the quality of the programs in your community school

Why do you need an Advisory Board?

1. You have too much to juggle on your own! (Heidi)
2. Help making decisions about programs (Amon)
3. Problem-solving together (Keirstin)

Who is on the Advisory Board?

They can become your quality improvement team!!!

How can your AB help in Quality Improvement Process?
