Looking at all growth by students and families including qualitative.

Collecting data and evidence from participants and measuring it against identified goals.

staff will develop skills to support the social, team, and social and emotional behaviors through their participation in team-building and arts activities to support student academic achievement.

collect feedback from a survey sent to participants

Surveys of parents, students and teachers. We really want to hear more from parents about their engagement.

Measuring how many participants we have, measure academic growth from start to end, attendance, parent and student retention.

Attendance, Evidence based curriculums with pre and post tests, parent engagement, community partnerships

Attendance and how many families we were able to help. Revisiting our programs and see if they are working for the students and if they are enjoying it.

Program retention is always a good sign of program success.

measuring academic, SEL, and attendance growth. we leverage partnerships with cloud-based data management and analytics programs to support evaluation

Integrated attendance and academic with our SIS systems; focus groups; participant surveys

The standard student performance elements (attendance in-school and after, grades, behavior, standardized tests) interviews, focus groups, photos or projects and activities.

Teacher Surveys

Collecting data from school, participants, instructors, and parents.

look at data from behavior, attendance and NWEA test result
